S3 Tracking and Monitoring Reports

We recognise the role that you will play in ensuring your child achieves success and hope you will find our tracking and monitoring reports helpful.

The first of two reports to be issued this session is the other attachment to this email. This report is the more basic of the two, providing an overview of performance to help support early intervention. The report contains a progress grade, ratings for effort, behaviour, and homework, and an explanatory next steps comment where required. We encourage you to use the report as stimulus for deeper discussion with your child about their progress.

Due to the sizeable administrative task involved in the distribution of reports by email to parent/carer(s) and pupil, we set a distribution window for reports. We aim to complete distribution of this report by Friday 28/10/22. Please see the guide to understanding your child's report at the end of this letter.

Guide to Understanding Your Child's Report

Effort, Behaviour, and Homework

➤ Effort	The extent to which the learner works hard, is motivated, participates in lessons and comes fully prepared.
➤ Behaviour	The extent to which the learner behaves in class, is focused and on task.
➤ Homework	The extent to which the learner completes homework on a regular basis, to an acceptable level.

In order to maximise consistency across the school, we report using three categories: Good, Inconsistent and Unsatisfactory.

➤ Good	The learner consistently meets expectations.
➤ Inconsistent	The learner is inconsistent in meeting expectations.
➤ Unsatisfactory	The learner is not meeting expectations.

Progress

Grade 1 Likely to progress to N5 in S4.

Grade 2 Likely to progress to N5 or N4 in S4.

Grade 3 Likely to progress to N4 or N3 in S4.
