IRIS Connect gives teachers the opportunity to record classroom-based teaching and learning using their App and Discovery Kit. All videos are securely transferred to the teacher's personal, password protected account on their cloud-based platform.

This will help to further enhance the teaching and learning experience across the school for all of our young people.






Young STEM Leader Award

Congratulations is in order for Louis Whyte, S6. At 16 years old, making his Scotland U20s Athletics International debut in Cardiff, Louis won Silver in Long Jump (his longest jump of the year at 7.09m) and Bronze in Triple Jump.

If that wasn't enough challenge, Louis also committed to compete at the U17 English Athletics National Championships, travelling to Birmingham for the Long Jump in the same weekend. Louis achieved a jump of 7.02m in the final round to win Silver.
