These will include information on how literacy difficulties are identified, support strategies and tools, assessment and SQA exam support arrangements, study skills and where to get support. Teaching staff have completed Dyslexia Module 1 (2023/24) and will receive additional training, so they have a good understanding of how to support dyslexic learners. Parental feedback - 70% of parents will agree/strongly agree with the statement "my child receives the help he/she needs to do well" (from 54% in 2023-24).
