- ◆ understand and use a modern language in a number of different situations
- ◆ apply your knowledge of a modern language in a number of different settings

The Course will help you develop and improve your literacy and numeracy skills by providing you with opportunities to read, listen, talk and write in a modern language, and to reflect on how this relates to English.

TOPICS COVERED: What will I talk about?

You, your family & pets; food in other countries; shopping; sports and hobbies and your school and the schools in the countries you are learning about.

TEACHING METHODS – What will I do?

Studying a language enables you to communicate directly with people from different countries and will help you to understand and learn about other cultures.

You will have access to a variety of up-to-date resources including the Internet and ICT to support and inform your learning. You will also work with other departments and complete project work in different topic areas.

You will develop your reading, listening, writing and talking skills through a variety of differentiated and stimulating activities allowing you to work independently, in pairs and as part of a group.
