## Teaching methods – What will I do?

You will have access to a variety of up-to-date paper and digital resources, including the Internet, to support and inform your learning. You will develop your reading, listening, writing and talking skills through a variety of differentiated and stimulating activities which will require you to work independently, in pairs and as part of a group. Other teaching methods will include:

- Role play
- Presentations -individual and/or group

#### Assessment

You will be given regular feedback on your work, and insight into how you can improve and develop your skills further. You will be given feedback as the course progresses based on your on-going work and any internal/ formal assessment tasks you complete.

20 marks (12.5% of overall mark)

## Component 5 – Talking (coursework completed in school)

• 30 marks (25% of overall mark)

In addition, there will be regular written homework to consolidate classwork and prepare for talking and writing activities and assessments. You will be issued with printed and digital resources on your iPad for use in class, homework and revision.
