Chris Munro is Executive Director of Growth Coaching International (GCI), a Sydney-based organisation recognised as a global leader in the field of Coaching in Education. Chris graduated from the University of Glasgow in 1992 and began his career as a Teacher of Technological Education at Oldmachar Academy, Aberdeen. Over the following 18 years, he was a Principal Teacher, Curriculum Support Officer, SQA verifier, and Programme Director of the Primary and Secondary PGDE at the University of Aberdeen. After relocating to Australia, Chris was a Professional Learning leader and coach in Government and Independent Catholic schools before joining GCI in 2017.

Chris describes his current role as supporting others at the intersection of strategy, leadership, learning and relationships – helping them make progress, one conversation at a time. He is an accredited Senior Practitioner with the European Mentoring and Coaching Council (EMCC Global), holds a Master of Research degree from the University of Aberdeen, and is a Fellow of the Australian Council for Educational Leaders in Victoria. Chris regularly writes and speaks about coaching and leadership, and is the co-author of *Growth Talk: A Coaching Way of Leading in Schools* (Munro & Campbell, 2025).
