
HOW YOU CAN HELP WITH WRITING INSTRUCTIONS

Correct sequence

Functional Writing - Instructions

When writing instructions children learn to:

use a suitable title.

only include the information needed.

use words and phrases about the topic.

use words like first and then.

put information in the right order.

write sections about what you need and what you do.

Tools for writing

- Use capital letters, full stops and commas correctly.
- * Used numbering, underlining and spacing
- Spell familiar words correctly using phonics.
- * Use ordering words e.g. after, then, next, finally.
- * Use joined up writing.
- * Use a dictionary for tricky words.
