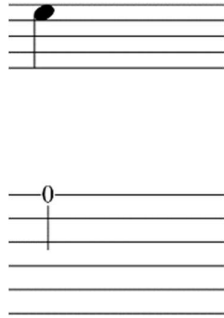


## Notes on the first string

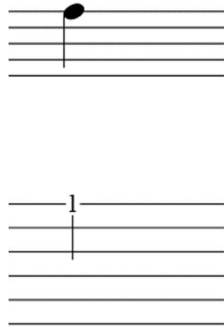
The high "E" string is often referred to as the first or top string. It's the thinnest string and sits closest to the ground when you're in playing position. The first three notes we'll learn are:

**E**



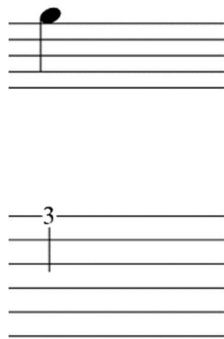
*Open string (no fingers)*

**F**



*First finger on the first fret.*

**And G**



*Third finger on the third fret.*
