# Primary 3A

# Literacy & English

- Learn new spelling patterns and common words using a variety of strategies.
- Continue to learn the first handwriting joins.
- Engage in personal reading and discuss books with others.
- Develop skills in extending writing through using conjunctions and a variety of sentence openers.
- Learn to use different types of punctuation.
- Develop functional writing skills.
- Listen and respond to Shetland poems and stories.

# Physical Education

- Develop flexibility, determination and resilience in athletics.
- Develop focus and attention in racket activities.
- Develop communication when playing rounders.

- Learn how to read basic maps.
