S4 Preparations for NQ exams during April/May 2024

Dear Parent/Carer

At this time of the session it is appropriate to provide an overview on the information which will help pupils preparing for N5 examinations in May. One of the most important strategies pupils need to consider is additional study at home. This could be choosing to revise earlier work, making own revision notes, trying past papers and using revision materials provided by their teacher or online revision materials.

Pupil support and subject teachers are happy to assist pupils with advice on their preparation approaches and there is an ongoing regular pattern of study clubs each week (see appendix 1) where pupils can access additional opportunities to discuss any issues. Clubs have commenced and there is a parental/guardian permission slip attached to this letter.

A S4 report was issued earlier this month.

Main prelim examinations are anticipated to begin on Friday 2 February (detailed plan to follow) and these assessments give pupils an appreciation of the standard in April/May. After the prelims, an S4 interim report is generated to assist pupils focus on their needs and complete their coursework as well as possible.

Some subjects have portfolios or assignments which form part of the final assessment. It is therefore very important that pupils meet teacher set deadlines in order to avoid a rush towards the end of March

The National examination diet commences on Tuesday 23 April and a full itinerary for Aith School will be provided in March highlighting any local variations to the nationally stated exam times. You can view the national exam diet now at
