SUBJECT/ DEPARTMENT	FOCUS/STRATEGY
ART & DESIGN	<p>Art & Design courses are about the development of material handling skills for practical units and critical skills for Art & Design studies (the written element) which will inform and inspire the pupils own practical work and prepare them for the written exam.</p> <p>Homework/Extra work is essential, be it completing sketchbook work, gathering images for visual research written work/research for critical studies or doing practical work in after school workshops.</p> <p>Therefore, the Art & Design Department runs an ‘open door’ policy to enable students to do extra work and preparation at lunchtimes and after school. Students should check with staff for advice, practice papers, etc. To aid students in this work, certain specialist materials can be loaned out to them for use at home, as required.</p> <p><u>Practical & Critical portfolio work must be complete to achieve overall course award</u> For Art and Design Studies, students have personally collected information and images to help with their studies into the lives and works of the artists and designers they have chosen. The basic information provided by the Department as booklets or sheets is also available on Teams.</p> <p><u>Preparation for Written Exam</u> This year pupils will only be answering the full question paper on both EXPRESSIVE and DESIGN. – TAKE OUT this whole statement. ENGLISH	<p>Classrooms are available for English study at lunchtime and afterschool, Monday to Friday. If pupils are looking for a room to study in, then they must speak to their allocated teacher(s).</p> <p>Lunchtime and after school support from teachers is also available by arrangement.</p> <p>Pupils should make use of Teams where teachers will post relevant links, resources and revision materials as appropriate to the courses.</p>
ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Mrs Shields is available for advice at intervals and lunchtimes to help with class work, homework, exam skills and revision. Pupils should use class notes and additional revision resources and links posted on the team as part of regular ongoing revision. All pupils are encouraged to attempt questions from the topic past paper booklets accessible on the team and submit for feedback, in addition to those set as homework.
GEOGRAPHY	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Teachers are available for advice at intervals and lunchtimes to help with class work, homework, exam skills and revision. Both N5 and Higher pupils should use class notes, additional revision resources and links posted on their class teams as part of regular ongoing revision. This includes using RGS Chalk Talks which have been produced to support revision for all topics at N5, Higher and Advanced Higher levels. All pupils are encouraged to attempt questions from the topic past paper booklets accessible on the team and submit for feedback. Paper copies are also available.

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HISTORY	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Teachers are available for advice as required. Teachers are also available most intervals and lunchtimes to help with homework, exam skills and revision. After school revision for History is on Mondays & Thursdays in 3.07 from 15.45- 16.45. Pupils from any History class at any level are welcome to attend. Pupils have been issued with revision notes and past paper question booklets to help them develop their knowledge and skills for the exam in May. Pupils are encouraged to attempt questions regularly for homework and submit for marking.
HOME ECONOMICS	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Lunchtime support: Staff are available at lunchtimes, on request, to help pupils with work. Past Papers: All pupils will be issued with a revision booklet of past exam papers. Past papers are also available online. They are encouraged to complete these and submit for marking and feedback. Study aids available to borrow eg tarzia puzzles, question and answer cards. Revision/help sessions on Monday after school and any other time as requested by pupil.
MATHS	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> After-school Supported Study Sessions (3.45pm - 5pm) are available each week as follows: For N4/N5 Maths/Apps and Higher Maths/Apps: Mondays: Mrs Galbraith (2.04) – Higher, Mr Kingston (2.05) – N5 Thursdays: Mr Irvine (2.37) – N5/Higher Other courses: Extra support available, speak to your Maths teacher. Lunchtime support: Maths department staff are available at lunchtimes, on request, to help pupils with work. Past Papers: All pupils will be issued with a revision booklet of past exam papers. Past papers are also available online. There are also teams for those studying N5 Maths, N5 Apps, H Maths, H Apps where extra resources are available. Maths notes: Always ensure your notes are up to date, if you are missing some notes, speak to someone else in the class or your teacher. Use your notes to help you revise. Teams: There are AHS teams for: N5 Maths, N5 Apps, H Maths, H Apps where extra revision materials are available, including checklists. All pupils taking these courses should be a member of the relevant team. Please speak to your teacher if you need help accessing this. <p>Practice: The key to success in Maths is to practise as much as you can. Keep up with exercises, and spend time persevering with questions, including past-papers, asking for any help that you need.</p>
MODERN LANGUAGES	<p>Teachers are available at lunchtimes Monday –Friday for support.</p> <p>After- school study sessions are available on request for all languages. Arrange this with your teacher.</p> <p>Teams has lists of all the revision websites available to help home revision.</p> <p>Reading and Listening Past papers are uploaded onto Teams pages regularly.</p> <p>Homework – should be focussing mainly on the WRITING and TALKING elements of the course at this stage.</p>
MODERN STUDIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Revision materials and sample exam questions are available on Microsoft Teams. Regular practise of exam style questions is recommended – these are also set as homework tasks. Pupils are encouraged to use a range of revision techniques – e.g. use of flashcards, mind maps, etc. Teachers are available for advice as required. After school revision sessions may also be made available on request.
