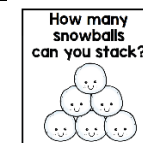
Build in the snow

Snow Science

- Make 2 snowballs O O
- Take them inside and place each snowball in a small plastic bowl
- Sprinkle 1 heaped teaspoon of salt over one snowball
- Watch what happens!

Questions:
 Which snowball melted first? Why?
 Why is it a good idea to throw salt on the pavements when it is frosty?

Footprints

Make footprints or tracks in the snow.
 Take a walk outside and touch and feel different textures.
 Make a snow angel.
 Build a snowman.
 Use a stick or twig to draw in the snow.
 Carefully crack the ice in puddles.
 Catch a snowflake on your hand.
