### **Snow Science**

- Make 2 snowballs OO
- Take them inside and place each snowball in



- a smallplastic bowl Sprinkle 1 heaped teaspoon of salt over one snowball
- Watch what happens!



#### Questions:

Which snowball melted first? Why? Why is it a good idea to throw salt on the pavements when it is frosty?

Did you know that the gritter spreads a mixture of grit and salt on the roads to melt the ice. This



prevents road accidents in Winter.
