




Winter Weather Home Learning

Try on each other's hats / coats / boots.</p>	<p>Frozen Nature Blocks:</p>  <p>Winter Stories Kids book read aloud: Snowball by Sue Hendra & Paul Linnet Pete the Cat Snow Daze Animated Book Read aloud</p>	<p>Build in the snow</p>   <p>A snow caterpillar (make lots of snowballs) Use Mr Potato Head items in a snowball to make characters.</p>	<p>How many snowballs can you stack?</p>  <p>Snow Science</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make 2 snowballs  • Take them inside and place each snowball in a small plastic bowl  • Sprinkle 1 heaped teaspoon of salt over one snowball  • Watch what happens!  <p>Questions: Which snowball melted first? Why? Why is it a good idea to throw salt on the pavements when it is frosty?</p>
<p>Footprints Make footprints or tracks in the snow. Take a walk outside and touch and feel different textures. Make a snow angel. Build a snowman. Use a stick or twig to draw in the snow. Carefully crack the ice in puddles.
