Suitable footwear and warm clothing (including a jacket) are encouraged throughout this term as when the weather allows children are encouraged to go outside for fresh air and exercise.

Pupil Absences/Appointments

Parents/carers are asked to **report all absences**, between 0830 and 0930, on each day of absence. The Scottish Government advises that where the school does not receive notification from parents/carers, pupils absence will be recorded as 'truancy'.

Where the school has not been informed of an absence, staff will endeavour to contact parents/carers/emergency contacts before 1030 to ensure they are aware that their child is not at school and to confirm the reason for their absence.

If parents/carers cannot be contacted, the absence will be referred to the school management team who will decide on the most appropriate action to take. If a child is still unannounced for at **1100** we will pass this on to Duty Social Work.

Schools are legally obliged to keep records of both authorised and unauthorised absences and these are reported annually to the Scottish Government. Requests for planned absences should be submitted on a <u>Pupil Absence Form.</u>
