Care Inspectorate inspection

Bell's Brae Nursery was recently visited by the Care Inspectorate on 16/17th September 2025. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate the quality of care and education we provide for the children and to ensure that we continue to meet national standards.

We are delighted that the inspection went well. Their feedback highlighted the dedication of the staff team in supporting all children in our care.

Key messages

- Children were cared for by kind, gentle and caring staff.
- Staff knew the children well and were skilled in supporting their care needs.
- Children had fun and were engaged in their play.
- The indoor environment was inviting and spacious with exciting resources for the children to explore. This should be developed further outdoors.
- Self-evaluation and quality assurance processes were effective to ensure high-quality care and learning opportunities.
- Staff worked well together and were enthusiastic and motivated in their professional development.
