NUMERACY & MATHEMATICS

- Develop ability to recognise and describe 2D and 3D shapes.
- Measure - estimating and measuring length, weight and volume
- Revise and consolidate odds and evens, ordinal numbers
- Counts forwards and backwards from any whole number up to 1000
- Describe, continue and create number patterns to recognise simple number sequences
