<u>Reading</u>

Reading will continue to be heard 2-4 times a week. Comprehension tasks to check understanding. Weekly library session in the Secondary Department to encourage reading in an interested area. Weekly class stories and discussions. We are focussing on using a loud clear voice when reading out loud and using expression for some.

<u>Writing</u>

Recap on alphabet formation upper and lower case, remembering where letters sit on the line. Weekly spelling focus on particular sounds. Active spelling games and activities matched to this.
