EXPRESSIVE ARTS

LITERACY & ENGLISH

Complete the last sounds which are taught in Primary 1 and revise all those learned - reading and writing words using the sounds.

Handwriting - correct formation and size of all letters (and numbers)

Capital letters – learn all capital letters – match to lower case one, write them and know when to use them.

Continue to learn and recognise key words.

Rhyme – be able to think of a word which rhymes with a given word.

Listening to stories regularly in class - focus on new vocabulary in the story. Retell familiar stories. Create their own writing - stories, lists, cards, signs with increasing independence. (sounding out words and using familiar key words).

NUMERACY & MATHEMATICS

Money – recognise coins to £2, make amounts up to 10p (and beyond).

Fractions - equal parts including halves and quarters.

Sharing - sharing items equally among groups Patterns - continuing and making patterns using shapes, coloured blocks and other items. Adding and taking away activities - using symbols +, -, =. (to 10 and beyond). Finding the missing number on a number line Symmetry
