Dear Parent/Guardian

Bikeability training will take place at school beginning **Monday 29th August 2022**, and on each following Monday afternoon for 5 weeks. Each pupil should bring their own bike and helmet to use where possible. If your child does not have access to a bike, can you please contact the school and we will organise one for them to borrow.

There will be staff from the Shetland Bike Project that will be visiting the school on the morning of **Thursday 25th August** to carry out general maintenance checks. This is necessary to ensure your child's bike is in a road worthy condition before the training begins. Please can you make sure your child brings their bike to school on this day.

Bikes can be delivered to school anytime in the morning, training will take place in the afternoon. Please leave them on the grass in the car park behind the school. The school can store any bikes left after 5.30pm in the shed for the duration of the training, or for collection at a future date.

For the training to take place we will require the assistance of a parent helper for road safety on the following dates: **Monday 5th, 12th, 19th and 26th September, from 1.45pm-2.45pm.** Any help would be much appreciated. Please contact the school if you are able to assist.
