






# P5/6 Curriculum Overview Term 1

<p><b>Literacy and English</b></p> 	<p><b>Reading</b> Pupils reading treetops this term. They will read in school with their group and at home. It is important that children read aloud some of their reading homework aloud with an adult or a sibling. This helps to develop fluency and expression when reading. Comprehension this term will stem from our topic 'Victorians'. We will be working on a range of different questioning strategies to develop our comprehension skills. We will also be reading 'Street Child' as our class novel and engaging with verbal comprehension throughout the story. Children will have access to the library weekly where they may choose a book to read in their own time.</p> <p><b>Writing</b> This term we will be focussing on a range of writing. We will be working on our punctuation and use of language to make our writing interesting. Our topic will provide a variety of writing experiences, such as letters, reports and diary entries. We will be developing our understanding of paragraphs and how to use them effectively throughout our writing. We will have spelling sessions throughout the week which will introduce spelling sounds/words, activities to consolidate the learning of these sounds/words and we will assess our learning through a weekly spelling test on a Friday.</p> <p><b>Listening and Talking</b> We will be developing our talking skills through class discussion and group activities. Pupils will speak informally in the class when sharing their work, giving feedback to peers, reading aloud etc. Pupils will also have opportunities to present their learning to the class.</p>
<p><b>Maths and Numeracy</b></p> 	<p><b>Number</b> work will be focusing on place value. We will learn how to order and sequence numbers, as well as how to round numbers to the nearest 10,100 and 1000. We will begin our topic on addition later this term.</p> <p><b>Data Handling</b> will be our topic maths focus this term.</p>
<p><b>Social Studies</b></p> 	<p>We are learning about Victorians. We will be learning about Queen Victoria and the British Empire. We also learn about what life was like for rich and poor Victorians. We will learn about the industrial revolution and how technology improved at this time.</p>
<p><b>Expressive Arts</b></p> 	<p><b>Art:</b> The class will have art with Mrs Burr on Friday mornings.</p> <p><b>Music:</b> The class will have music with Mrs Pottinger on Monday mornings.</p>
<p><b>RME</b></p>	<p>We are learning about Rites of Passage. We will be learning about important events in people's lives of all religions and thinking about our own significant life events.</p>
<p><b>Health and Wellbeing</b></p> 	<p><b>P.E.</b> This term P.E will be on a Monday morning and Tuesday afternoon. The class will also do their daily mile regularly. We will be revising the importance of hygiene as well.</p>
