








Curriculum Overview Term 2

<p>Literacy and English</p> 	<p>Reading This term pupils will enjoy reading different types of text using the Oxford Reading Tree (ORT) Scheme and develop their ability:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> to understand how and when to put expression into their reading to read with increasing fluency and accuracy to share their ideas and opinions about what they have read. to use punctuation to help them understand the meaning of the text to ask, answer and identify information from a text through comprehension activities <p>Writing Pupils will continue to :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> revise alternative spellings of vowel sounds and learn new ones using the Nelson scheme continue to build on the spelling of 'tricky' words. apply the spelling patterns they have learned as they write. form letters correctly, legibly and consistently (size and shape). practice joining handwriting more frequently increase the level of independence in own writing develop understanding of nouns, proper nouns, verbs and adjectives <p>They will also be encouraged to create texts through imaginative writing and topic work linked to our topic of 'The Romans'</p> <p>Listening and Talking</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Class, group and paired discussions Think, Pair, Share Asking and answering questions
<p>Maths and Numeracy</p> 	<p>Topics to be covered this term include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Number and Number Process: Multiplication and Division Multiply/divide mentally by 2x 3x 4x 5x and 10x / 6x 7x 8x 9x Time - Recognise half past/quarter to times on both analogue and digital clocks, and order times in 12 hour notation .Recording time - give times to and past the hour using digital displays 2D/3D Shape - Discuss the properties of 2D/3D shapes and create tiling patterns and build with 3D shapes. Begin to use the terms regular and irregular to describe 2D shapes. Identify prisms and other 3D shapes, using terms such as faces, edges and vertices.
<p>Sciences / Social Studies</p> 	<p>We will be learning about The Romans this term and cover areas including: Who were the Romans, Romans in Britain, the story of Romulus and Remus, Roman Soldiers, Where is Italy and what it is famous for and Volcanos - Pompeii.</p>
<p>Expressive Arts</p> 	<p>Art: The class will be producing art work alongside our Art Teacher Mrs Burr on Friday mornings. In class we will be creating art related to topic work.</p> <p>Music: The class will have music with Mrs Pottinger on a Monday morning. P1-4 will be performing a live or recorded Christmas Nativity in December.</p>
<p>Technologies</p> 	<p>Pupils will be continue practicing their keyboard typing skills and developing digital literacy across a range of contexts where they will be supported to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> explore and experiment with digital technologies to enhance learning use digital technologies responsibly to research, record and share or present information extend knowledge of how to use digital technology to communicate with others and awareness of ways to keep safe and secure.

The class will continue with the Daily Mile when weather to be outdoors.</p>
