





P7 Curriculum Overview Term 2

<p>Literacy and English</p> 	<p>Reading <u>Novels</u> Pupils will be reading in groups in school. Pupils should read aloud at home to practice fluency and expression. Comprehension this term will focus on writing clear answers using full sentences and finding information from a text. Children will have access to the library weekly. They will spend time reading alone or with friends.</p> <p>Writing This term we will be focussing on a range of writing which will be related to their topic. This includes recount writing, note taking and creating PowerPoint Presentations by selecting the relevant information. When writing the pupils will be encouraged to use detail, appropriate tone and language features consistently. We will have focussed handwriting and grammar lessons every week. We will have spelling sessions throughout the week which will introduce spelling sounds/words, activities to consolidate the learning of these sounds/words and we will continue to assess our learning through a weekly spelling test on a Friday.</p> <p>Listening and Talking we will be developing our talking skills through class discussion and group activities. We will build our vocabulary through regular Word Aware activities including using a dictionary and syllable detection. Pupils will continue to speak informally in the class such as sharing their work, giving feedback to peers, reading aloud etc. Pupils will also be expected to share their topic work presentations. Pupils will also be learning lines and practising performing for our school Christmas concert.</p>
<p>Maths and Numeracy</p> 	<p>Number work will be focusing on number (subtraction) and will start</p> <p>Shape will be our topic maths focus this term. Which includes properties of 2D shapes and 3D objects. The class will also be developing their knowledge of angles and symmetry.</p>
<p>Social Studies</p>	<p>The Victorians Pupils will be learning about events in the past, focusing on the Victorian era. Pupils will learn about schooling, housing, working lives, development of medicine, inventions and famous Victorians.</p>
<p>Expressive Arts</p> 	<p>Art: The class will have art with Mrs Burr on Friday mornings.</p> <p>Music: The class will have music with Mrs Pottinger on Monday mornings.</p>
<p>Health and Wellbeing</p> 	<p>This term, pupils will be learning about food and healthy eating. Pupils will understand what is meant by a balanced diet and nutrition. Pupils will also learn safe and hygienic practices.</p> <p>P.E. This term P.E will be on a Wednesday afternoon with Mr Kirkness.</p>
