Literacy

Listening and Talking

- We are learning about non-verbal techniques when giving presentations. For example; eye contact and body language.
- We can recognise techniques used by a presenter to engage or influence the listener.

Reading

- We are learning how to distinguish fact and opinion and can give reasons why.
- We can identify reliable sources of information and explain why they are reliable.

Writing

- We are creating a range of short and extended texts for different purposes. For example; poems, letters and reports.
- We are learning to acknowledge sources of information and can make it clear in our writing where the information came from.

Numeracy and Mathematics

Numeracy

- We are developing our understanding of multiplication and division and becoming confident with our table facts.
- We beginning to learn about multiplying and dividing two/three-digit numbers.
- We are learning about fractions. We will be able to find a fraction a quantity and of a number. We will also learn about equivalent fractions.

Money and Time

- We are developing our understanding of money. We will learn about how to calculate price increases and decreases.
- We will also be learning about common words related to money. For example; budget, statement, loan, and interest.
- We will be learning how to tell the time in both 12 hour and 24 hour clock.
