

Curriculum Overview - Primary 6/7 Mrs Georgeson and Mrs Robertson

Literacy

Listening and Talking

- We are practising talking and listening in groups. Taking on board opinions of others, turn taking, learning to agree and disagree.
- During a presentation and as a class pupils will actively listen to each other.
- They will consider their body position, eye-contact, audience engagement.

Reading

- We are learning to scan texts to find key information.
- We are practising answering inference, literal and evaluative questions using the Comprehension Box resource.

Writing

- We are learning to use language to engage the reader of our recounts.
- We are learning to select relevant ideas and information, and use it in a logical way.
- We are regularly practicing spelling groups and grammar.

Numeracy and Mathematics

Measure - length

- We can choose the appropriate unit of measure and measure implement eg ruler or metre stick
- We can convert units of measure cm - m, m to km etc
- We can use our knowledge of measure to calculate area and perimeter
- We can estimate length

Data handling

- We are learning to collect, organise and display data.
- We are learning to analyse, interpret and draw conclusions from a variety of data.
- We are learning to draw conclusions about the reliability of data.

Addition and Subtraction

- We can solve addition and subtraction problems using mental strategies. We can work with numbers to 1 and 2 decimal places.
- We can round to estimate our answers. Ensuring that it is reasonable.

Multiplication

- We are keeping our skills up in the multiplication tables

Forces and Magnetism

- I will participate in investigations into how friction including air resistance affect motion.
- I can suggest ways to improve my model making it more efficient
- I can use the terms force, drag, resistance, friction, aerodynamic, gravity, static
- I can measure force in newtons
- I can investigate how electrons become charged creating an electrostatic force
- Discuss magnetism and it's practical uses eg compass
- I will prepare a report on my investigations and findings

Health & Well-being

PE

- I will learn the game of handball and it's rules
