Curriculum Overview - Primary 1/2- Term 4 2023/24 - Mr Gill

Literacy

Listening and Talking

- We are strengthening the ability to hear, produce and write rhyming words.
- We are continuing to count how many syllables there are in words.
- During Drawing Club, we are learning new vocabulary and writing about characters and how they feel and react

Reading

- Through Drawing Club, we have a focused text where we are able to extend our vocabulary and discuss any issues raised.
- P1 we are learning to read single sounds, blend & build CVC words using the sounds: s,a,t,i,p,n,c,k,e,h, r, m, d, g, o, u, l, f, b & sound digraphs.
- P1/2 We are regularly reading our own books and using our phonic knowledge to decode words.
- P2 we are practising reading CCVC words, common words and our own reading books.

Writing

- We have the opportunity to write or mark make in a range of play, imaginative and real contexts.
- Through Drawing Club, we have the opportunity to enjoy a range of texts and write in response to stories.
- P1 we are continuing to develop our fine motor and scissor skills.
- P1 we are practising forming our letters correctly and using finger spaces.
- P2 we are revising digraphs and how to spell CCVC and common words in sentences. We are writing up to 5 sentences as part of our speedy skills
- P2 we are learning how to form letters correctly and use our phonic knowledge to spell words in our writing.
- Later this term we will be working on a short topic about castles
