<u>Literacy</u>

Listening and Talking

• We are developing the ability to hear and produce rhyming words.

• We are learning how many syllables are in words.

• During Drawing Club and daily stories, we are learning new vocabulary.

Reading

• Through Drawing Club, we have a focused text each week.

• P1 – we are learning to read single sounds and build CVC words using the sounds: s,a,t,i,p,n,c,k,e,h.

• P2 – we are practising reading CCVC words and writing simple sentences each day.

<u>Writing</u>

• We have the opportunity to write or mark make in a range of play, imaginative and real contexts.

• Through Drawing Club, we have the opportunity to innovate texts and create stories orally.

• P1 – we are developing our fine motor and scissor skills.

• P1 – we are developing a dynamic pencil grip.

• P2 – we are revising our single sounds and digraphs (oa, ie, ai, ue, oo, th) and using these to show how to spell CCVC words.

• P2 – we are learning how to form 'caterpillar' letters correctly and revising our letter formation skills.

Numeracy and Mathematics

Number & Number Processes

- P1 We are learning to read, sequence and count forwards and backwards within 20 and beyond.

- P1 We are learning to count using finger patterns, counters and arrays.
- P2 We are learning to read, sequence and count forwards and backwards within 100, working towards counting in 2s 5s and 10s
- • P2 We are practising number bonds to 10
- P2 We are learning to add by counting on from the biggest number

Shape, Position & Movement

- P1 We are learning positional language (in front, behind, over, under) and using it accurately
- We are learning to name, describe and sort 2D shapes (P1) and 3D shapes (P2) through Drawing Club and play.
