## Literacy

## Listening and Talking

- We can regularly select texts to read or listen to and explain our preferences to others.
- We can recognise techniques used by a presenter to engage or influence the listener.
- We can respond to questions about a given text and explain the main points or findings.

## Reading

- We are learning to read using expression, confidence and fluency.
- Pupils take part in regular choice reading throughout the week.
- Pupils read assigned books throughout each week individually and as a group.

# Writing

- We are currently taking part in the National Improving Writing Project to enhance pupils writing skills. We are looking specifically at using a variety of sentence openers.
- We are learning how to search for information to be used for a specific purpose.
- We are learning how to summarise information and create new texts using the main points.
- We are learning about the difference between fact and opinion and how to make sure information is reliable.
- Pupils practice spelling regularly in groups.
- Pupils explore a range of grammar to enhance their writing.
