## Literacy

## **Listening and Talking**

- We are developing our skills when speaking within a group, contributing effectively and taking turns.
- We are developing confidence when speaking to an audience whilst sharing our learning with others, either informally or in a presenting situation.

### Reading

- Pupils will have reading books weekly in school which will be read aloud to develop confidence and fluency.
  Reading will occur individually and as part of small groups.
