# Literacy

### **Curriculum links:**

#### Listening and Talking

- We are developing the ability to hear and produce rhyming words.
- P2 We are learning how many syllables are in words.
- During Drawing Club, we are learning new vocabulary.

### Reading

- Through Drawing Club, we have a focused text each week.
- We are listening to and appreciating a variety of texts and stories.
- P1 we are learning to read single sounds and build CVC words using the sounds: s,a,t,i,p,n,c,k,e,h.
- P2 we are practising reading CCVC words and simple sentences fluently.

#### Writing

- We have the opportunity to write or mark make in a range of play, imaginative and real contexts.
- Through Drawing Club, we have the opportunity to innovate texts and create stories orally.
- P1 we are developing our fine motor and scissor skills.
- P1 we are developing a dynamic pencil grip.
- P2 we are revising digraphs and how to spell CCVC words.
- P2 we are learning how to form 'caterpillar' letters correctly.
- P2 we are learning how to write up to 2/3 sentences correctly using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
