Dear Parents/Carers,

Myself and all school staff would like to welcome you back to a new term. We hope you are all well and keeping safe at this concerning time. As the Covid-19 situation continues to present challenges we return to remote learning for our pupils from Monday 11th till Friday 29th January.

We appreciate that parents may be juggling work and supporting children's' learning so we do not expect children to be working in the same way they would on a normal school day. As this situation continues it becomes increasingly important that we focus on core literacy and numeracy skills if time is short. For P5-7 learning materials are in trays marked with pupil's names. Some of the instructions and activities referred to on the blog for P5-7 will need materials from the trays. Please bring a homework folder or bag to take home these materials and leave the trays in the porch Sending work back by, taking photos or emailing messages to teachers lets them know how activities went and creates good opportunities for feedback which in turn helps to motivate pupils so we look forward to hearing from you and seeing all the great things you are doing. Please keep reading books and paper copies of completed work at home for the time being. We are all here to support you so please don't hesitate to get in touch if any aspect of remote learning is not working for you.
