Four things you can do at home with your family:

- Can you Choose It, Use It and Put It Away at home? It's tricky to remember all the time!
- Can you talk about your name as you write it in the morning? Remember to say the letter sounds, not Names ie. 'ahhh' for A and not 'ay'.
- Can you talk about the days of the week at home? What day is it today?
- Can you talk about something new you ate at nursery?
