Literacy

Listening and Talking

- Listening to and talking regularly about favourite fairytales
- Xmas Concert practise and performing in front of a large audience
- Group work including presenting ideas to rest of class

Reading

- Learning and practising our sounds.
- Using knowledge of sounds to read words and books.
- Choosing texts to read for enjoyment and developing interest in certain texts and authors

Writing

- Using phonics knowledge to sound out words to write.
- Enjoy creating texts of choice relating to our topic of Fairytales including letter writing as well as Christmas themed writing activities
- We will continue to practise letter formation in handwriting in small groups
- We will be focusing on correctly punctuating our sentences.
- Self checking our work for commonly-used words and knowledge of letter patterns and spelling rules.

Numeracy

- Learning and applying division and table facts.
- P2: 2x table/division facts
- P3: 2/4 x table - use doubling to help
- P4: 2/4/8 x table - use doubling to help

Money

- Use money to pay for items and work out how much change I should receive.
- Investigate how different combinations of coins and notes can be used to pay for goods or be given in change.

Time

- Tell the time using 12 hour clocks, realising there is a link with 24 hour notations, explain how it impacts on daily routines and impacts on events happening throughout the day.
- Develop an understanding of how long tasks take by measuring the time taken to complete a range of activities using a variety of timers.
