Term 3 - 2025/2026

Literacy

Listening and Talking

- Listening skills - practising good listening and talking skills.
- Note taking - take short notes when listening or watching others.
- Use these to help produce leaflets/posters.

Reading

- Learning and practising our sounds.
- Weekly use of library (Wed/Thurs) Choosing texts to read for enjoyment and developing interest in certain texts and authors
- Comprehension activities - identify the main ideas of texts
- Looking over set reading tasks at home so we practise reading out loud and reading with expression.
- Writing
- Using phonics knowledge to sound out words to write.
- Enjoy creating texts of our choice - once week while using grammar and punctuation rules.
- We will continue to practise letter formation in handwriting in small groups
- Posters/leaflets related to topic - using technology

Numeracy and Mathematics

Fractions

- Explore how groups of items can be shared equally.
- Find a fraction of an amount
- Through practical activities show understanding of simple fractions including equivalent fractions.

Place Value

- Share ideas with others to develop ways of estimating eg doubling
- Check estimation with actual answer
- Round whole numbers to at least the nearest 10,100 and check up against solution.

Continue working on time

- Tell the time using 12 hour clocks, realising there is a link with 24 hour notations, explain how it impacts on daily routines and impacts on events happening throughout the day.
- Develop an understanding of how long tasks take by measuring the time taken to complete a range of activities using a variety of timers.

Angle, symmetry and transformation

- Describe, follow and record routes and journeys using signs, words and angles associated with direction and turning
- Explore symmetry in own and wider environment
- Develop awareness of grid references
