

Term 4 Overview: Primary 5-7 2025/2026

Literacy

Listening and Talking - personal projects

Reading

P5 - We will continue to read aloud in groups, to further increase fluency in reading to improve comprehension.

P6 and 7 - This term we will do novel studies and write book reports. We will use note taking to help us with this.

Writing

This term we are pulling all our writing skills together to assess if pupils can apply these in longer pieces of writing. We will be doing a variety of personal, factual and imaginative writing. These skills include punctuation, description, logical order, paragraphs, spelling, conjunctions, sentence variation, handwriting and checking writing makes sense. (LIT 2-21, 22, 23, 24)

Topics

Enterprise

Plan a fundraiser for the school trip. (HWB 2-12a)

Earth - We will be learning about Earth and presenting findings to the class. We will be working with: - Earth's Materials, Plants, ECO systems, Food chains, Landscapes, Animals, The water Cycle, Renewable and non-renewable energy. (SCN 2-01, 02, 03, 04, 05)

Personal Projects - research a topic chosen by each pupil. Create a poster/mode/talk about the topic and present to groups or the class.

Elections - With the election coming up in May, we will learn about democracy and discuss the rights and responsibilities that citizens in Scotland have. And how this impacts their lives.

We will also do a mini science project where we will be working with circuits, substances and chemical changes. (SCN 2-09, 10, 15, 16)

Numeracy and Mathematics

Maths:

Probability/Chance - We will learn the vocabulary used when working with probability. We will do activities that involve describing likelihood of events. We will conduct different experiments involving chance.

We will use our knowledge of time to- work with 12- and 24-hour clocks, both in hours and minutes. We will also look at calendars. We will read an array of timetables, plan journeys and plan events.

Capacity/volume - We will measure the capacity/volume of different objects in litres, centilitres and millilitres. We will also convert between the different units of measurements.

Numeracy - Pupils will continue with individual numeracy as well as Number Blast whole class lessons to contribute to their Numeracy Scrapbooks. Assessing place value, number operations, estimating and rounding, percentages, decimals, fractions.

Practising times tables and long multiplication at home will be very helpful.
