Curricular Area	Subject	Topic(s)
Languages	English	DA: Critical Essay Writing; Shetland Young Writer; Poetry Unit CM: Transactional Writing: Sports.
	French	Using and Understanding language (Reading and Listening) will be based around the film “Les Choristes” and future holidays . Grammar focus - future tense . Pupils will continue communicating with pupils from Collège Le Dimitile in Reunion Island .
Numeracy	Maths	Formulae – patterns, sequences and change of subject. Scale factors and associated calculations. Areas and volumes including quadrilaterals and prisms. Creating and solving equations and inequalities with fractions and brackets. Using scientific notation.
HWB	PE	S2 will complete a football unit where they will complete a football season in a team. In each team every pupil will be given a role to complete to help their team succeed. The focus of this unit is to develop sportsmanship and football specific skills. The season will comprise of a preseason, main season and a final event where pupils can show case the skills and knowledge learnt previously.
	Life Skills	Pupils will be learning about substance misuse: units related to alcohol, safe and unsafe behaviours, the action to be taking in an emergency relating substance misuse and the long/ short term effects of substance misuse.
	RME	Rites of Passage: research and reporting on how religious and non-religious groups mark an important life stage.
	Home Ec	S2 pupils will be continuing to develop practical skills. While reinforcing hygiene and safety in the kitchen. They are also going to explore hygiene requirements for the food industry.
Science	Science	Manufacturing This term we will be investigating everyday objects such as battery production, crude oil distillation and products made from it. Along with practical investigation into enzymes and there uses.
Social Studies	Geography	Pupils will complete the Geography of Food unit by looking at the impact of food miles on the environment, the importance of shopping seasonally and the benefits of Fair Trade on communities and farmers.
	History	Continue to investigate World War Two in particular the D-Day landings and the end of the war.
	Modern Studies	Rights and responsibilities they have as citizens of the modern world.
Expressive Arts	Art	Pupils will be working on art theory and artist research before emoving onto a lino printing project.
	Music	Continue to develop performing skills on two instruments of their choice. Film music unit which includes listening concepts, theory and creative tasks.
Technologies	BIC	Continue to work with Databases. Product development within a business environment, from market research to luching a new product to the market.
	Technical	Complete stool construction and continue with CAD exercises. Time permitting the class will attempt a three part puzzle in wood.
