





PJP ARCHITECTS VISIT.

THIS WAS FOLLOWED BY AN ACTIVITY GIVEN TO THE PUPILS BY IAN. IT WAS A VERY ACTIVE AFTERNOON WITH AN INSIGHT INTO WHAT IS INVOLVED IN DESIGNING AND BUILDING A HOUSE AS WELL AS AN OVERVIEW OF THE KIND OF PATH TO FOLLOW IF YOU WANT TO BE AN ARCHITECT. 






ROYAL NAVY VISIT

A REMINDER TO PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT YOU PRE ORDER MEALS FOR YOUR CHILD/REN ON PARENTPAY. BOOKINGS CAN BE ENTERED AS OFTEN AS YOU LIKE WHETHER THIS IS WEEKLY, FORTNIGHTLY OR TERMLY – AS LONG AS THEY ARE MADE BEFORE THE BOOKING-CUT OFF. BOOKINGS ARE OPEN UP TO 10 WEEKS IN ADVANCE.



IT IS IMPORTANT TO ENSURE YOUR BOOKINGS ARE MADE BEFORE THE CUT OFF TO GUARANTEE YOUR CHILD WILL RECEIVE THEIR CHOICE OF MEAL. MEAL CHOICES CANNOT BE GUARANTEED IF BOOKINGS ARE ADDED ONTO THE SYSTEM AFTER THESE CUT-OFF DATES AS INGREDIENTS WILL ALREADY HAVE BEEN ORDERED AND CANTEEN STAFF WILL BE COOKING TO THE NUMBER OF BOOKED MEALS.

IF YOUR CHILD IS TAKING A HOME PACKED LUNCH, PLEASE ENSURE YOU LOG ONTO PARENTPAY AND CHOOSE THE 'PACKED LUNCH FROM HOME' OPTION.
