

# Upper Primary Home Learning Activities

Here are some optional activities you can complete at home.

## Literacy:

Find a poem about snow/Christmas/winter. You could look online or in books you have at home.

Write your own poem in the same style as the one you have found.

Spend time getting cosy and enjoy reading a book you have at home!  
Extra: Write a short review on the book (or any chapters) you have read.

## Numeracy:

Conduct a survey with the people in your house. You can choose the topic or select from the options below:

1. Favourite hot drink
2. Favourite thing to do in the snow.

Sum up the results of your survey with a sentence i.e "The most popular hot drink was Hot Chocolate".

Create a bar chart to show your survey results.

Revise the times tables that you feel less confident with.

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## Health & Wellbeing:

Find a cosy spot and sit quietly for 5 minutes. Listen to the sounds around you. Draw or write one thing that made you feel calm.
