Curricular Area	Subject	Topic(s)
Languages	English	DA: writing and producing CUHA sketch; Writing to Convey Information; RUAE; Poetry Reading and writing. CM: Core reading skills.
	French	Using language (Speaking and Writing) and Understanding language (Reading and Listening) will be based around hobbies . The grammar focus will be on using verbs .
Numeracy	Maths	Number – extend knowledge of fractions, decimals and percentages – including applications. Measurement – calculating lengths, areas, volumes and weights and common unit conversions. Angles - angle sum of a triangle, complementary, supplementary, alternate, corresponding and vertically opposite angles. Time – time intervals and S/D/T calculations
HWB	PE	Pupils will complete three units this term fitness, basketball and badminton. In each unit, we will focus on developing overall fitness, sport-specific skills, knowledge, and building individual confidence.
	Life Skills	Pupils will be learning about the importance of resilience and how to look after their mental health. We will explore ways to incorporate positive mental health in everyday life.
	RME	Students will be exploring world religions.
	Home Economics	The Journey of food – In this unit and highlighted during practical cooking will be the origin of food and the common cooking methods.
Science	Science	How does it work? Part 1 - Exploring force and how electricity is produced. Part 2 - Human body- examining why we breathe and how the immune system works
Social Studies	Geography	Pupils will be learning about developed and developing countries. They will learn the indicators that show a country's level of development and will compare their lives to the life of a young girl living in rural Malawi.
	History	Students will be looking at Celtic society.
Expressive Arts	Art	Pupils will be completing a cross curricular project with science. We will build a model of the school looking at renewable energies. Pupils will also look at repeat pattern and using these in designs
	Music	Keyboard unit which includes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Playing technique • Music theory • Composing opportunities • Practicing listening skills
Technologies	BIC	Students will be looking at how businesses provide for society and running a virtual business to make a profit.
	Technical	Completing the technical box. Working with plastics and wood making phone stands using housing joint and corner rebate. In Graphics pupils will try out Oblique drawing with 3x5 lettering and look at nets.
