

# TERMLY OVERVIEW

PRIMARY 5-7 TERM 3 2023/2024

## TOPIC - Materials

This will include learning about:

- The process of the water cycle investigating different water samples from the environment
- Earths substances, making comparisons of characteristics and uses
- Investigating floating and sinking making practical challenges to compare buoyancy
- Taking part in activities involving chemical reactions
- Investigating how substances can produce other substances and describe how characteristics have changed
- Participating in activities to separate mixtures of substances, relating to everyday experiences
- Investigating speed of dissolving different substances

### LITERACY

**Reading** - pupils will continue to read a variety of books in class. This term we will focus on novels and starting to complete novel studies.

Writing - we will be completing writing club this term and creating short and extended texts. We will be focusing on appropriate vocabulary to suit purpose and audience.

**Spelling** - we will continue spelling on Mondays, practising in class on Thursdays and setting a challenge on Fridays.

Listening and Talking - will be embedded through topic work and classroom discussions, pupils will deliver personal talks of their choice.

## NUMERACY

This term our numeracy topics will be:

- Multiplication
- Division
- Fractions, decimal fractions and percentages
- Time
- Expressions and equations
