



TERMLY OVERVIEW

PRIMARY 1-3 TERM 2 2025/2026

TOPIC This term our topic is 'Earth/Our World'

- We will be observing and recording the sun and moon at various times
- Investigating forces on toys and other objects
- Exploring the forces exerted by magnets, learners will be designing a magnetic game
- Learning how to help care for our environment through reduce, reuse and recycle
- Understanding how technologies help provide for our needs and wants

LITERACY

Primary 1 will cover the remaining Jolly Phonics letter sounds and start early word blending, cvc words. They will get their first Oxford Reading Tree wordless books home, meeting the ORT characters.

Primary 2 and 3 will be developing their writing independence, continuing to learn new spelling patterns and common/tricky words. They will be writing diary entries, instructions and stories, whilst identifying and using nouns and adjectives.

NUMERACY

The focus for primary 1 will be addition within 10 with some extension tasks.

Primary 2 and 3 will be looking at number bonds and addition and subtraction. We will also be recapping number order and place value.

We will also be doing some lessons on shape, exploring 2D and 3D shapes.

HEALTH AND WELLBEING

PE – Our PE specialist teacher, Mr Williamson, will be in school every Friday. Class PE with Miss Clubb will be on Tuesdays.

Our HWB lessons will focus on being aware of and able to express feelings and developing the ability to talk about them. Using the Colour Monster book to support learning.

Thursdays – Music with Miss O'Dwyer

Fridays - PE with Mr Williamson

Pupils will have opportunities to engage in expressive arts in the classroom during interdisciplinary learning.
