

# TERMLY OVERVIEW

PRIMARY 6 - 7 TERM 2 2025/2026

#### Topic World Religions

This term, we will be exploring stories, and key figures from a range of world religions. Through discussion, creative writing, and reflection, pupils will develop their understanding of the beliefs, values, and moral lessons shared across different faiths. We will investigate and reflect on stories from major world religions such as Christianity, Islam, Judaism, Hinduism, and Buddhism. Pupils will explore the similarities and differences between these religions.

They will also reflect on moral values such as kindness, honesty, respect, and compassion, and how these shape the way people live.

This topic encourages respect, empathy, and an appreciation of diversity in beliefs and traditions around the world.

#### Literacy

Reading - Pupils will continue to read a variety of books in class and we will do ERIC time after lunch. This term our class Novel will be Matilda.

**Writing** - Our class focus will be conjunctions, sentence length and punctuation.

**Spelling** - Will be done with Mrs Christie on Fridays. New spelling words every Friday.

Listening and Talking - will be embedded through topic work and classroom discussions, pupils will deliver personal talks of their choice.

## Numeracy

This term our numeracy topics will be:

- Addition and subtraction
- Time
- Angles, symmetry and transformation
- Weekly lessons on data handling will continue.

### Health and wellbeing

Health and wellbeing topics for this term: PE- will be done with our PE specialist teacher, Mr Williamson on Fridays.

Class PE with Miss McLean will be on Mondays.

This term, pupils will explore how to make informed food choices by learning about the nutritional value of different foods. They will develop their understanding of how diet impacts overall health and wellbeing, including energy levels, concentration, and growth.

#### Homework

Pupils will receive weekly spelling patterns on Mondays to practise throughout the week. We will have a spelling challenge on Friday to test their words.
