



# TERM 4 OVERVIEW

PRIMARY 1-3 TERM 4 2025/2026

**TOPIC** This term our topic is **Farm to Fork**.

- Identifying where foods come from
- Making simple recipes by following instructions accurately
- Explaining how advertising can affect choices
- Developing an awareness of farming jobs in our local community
- We are hoping at the end of term to run a café for the rest of the school, offering a selection of foods that the children will have grown.

## LITERACY

Primary 1 will continue to practice blending sounds to develop their confidence in reading independently. We will be learning about the 'Tools for Writing', and how to put together sentences.

Primary 2 and 3 will focus on punctuation, connectives and (for some) sentence openers. I will be in touch nearer the time regarding primary 1-3 taking part in **show and tell** to support their development of listening and talking skills.

## NUMERACY

Primary 1 will consolidate their learning of numbers within 20, and undertake a sequence of lessons on **money**, beginning with coin recognition. Primary 2 and 3 will also be doing some work on money, including calculating total spend and change, as well as a series of lessons on compass points

The whole class will also be learning about **information handling**, and how data can be represented in different ways.

## HEALTH AND WELLBEING

PE – Our PE specialist teacher, Mr Williamson, will be in school every Friday.

Our annual **Sports Day** will take place in June, and families are invited to attend. With the hope of improved weather, we plan to carry out learning activities outdoors. Primary 1-7 pupils will also be participating in **Da Voar Redd Up**.
