Dear Parents/Carers

As we approach the end of term 2 we would like to share some important dates and information.

Christmas Outdoor Performance Important Arrangements

We are looking forward to seeing you at our outdoor, Christmas performance of songs and instrumental solo items this year in the playground. This socially distanced event, for parents and carers, will take place on Tuesday 15th December at 2.15pm. We are really hoping the weather is kind to us however, if the weather is very poor we will be able to film our performance and share this with you digitally. We will let you know by email if the performance is not taking place due to poor weather.

We very much appreciate in advance your cooperation with the following guidance to keep us all safe and well. We regret that we are unable to extend invitations to wider family bubbles.

I will be available to meet parents/carers at the large gate in the playground from 2.05pm and will ask you to hand sanitise and to enter the playground wearing face coverings. Socially distanced 'stars' will be drawn on the playground and you will be asked to stand on your star and to maintain a 2m social distance from others for the duration of the performance. We have a very limited number of seats on the picnic benches. We would like to keep these for anyone who would benefit from having a seat. If you would prefer to watch the performance from the playground fence, please feel free to do so, whilst maintaining a 2m social distance from others. Please feel free to take a cup of something fine and hot with you to keep away the winter chills! Santa has made us aware that he will be passing by the school to deliver his Christmas presents to the Ollaberry bairns after the performance has finished. We will listen out for his bells!

Please do not attend our Christmas Outdoor Performance if you or anyone in your household is displaying COVID-19 symptoms. The main symptoms to look out for remain -

- a new, continuous cough
- fever/high temperature
- a loss of, or change in, sense of smell or taste.
