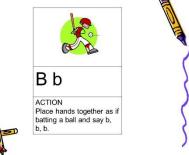
### Reading aloud

Find a cosy spot and choose someone at home to read your reading book aloud to. Talk about the story and the pictures.

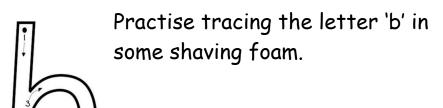
#### New letter
