Near Doubles

When we double numbers, it can help you to add numbers that are close to each other.

If you double the number you know and then you can add on or take away the difference.

If you know that $10 + 10 = 20$ then this can help you work out $10 + 11$.

$10 + 11$ is the same as $10 + 10 + 1$ which makes 21.
