<p>Do you have a ruler and or measuring tape? Find things to measure around the house and compare from longest to shortest</p> <p>Do some baking with a grown up - talking about amounts and order of what to do eg first, next, finally.</p> <p>How far up can you count up in 2s. This is the 2 times table and these numbers are all even. Can you tell anything else about counting in 2s?</p> <p>Can you find any 3D shapes inside or outside your house? Cyclinders? Cubes? How many and what.</p> <p>Snow experiment (linked to work on water in Term 2) What happens to the snow if you change its location? Put snow in 3 cups/containers. Sit one inside your front door/in porch area, one on the table in kitchen/living room and one in the freezer. Check back in every hour for 3 hours and see what the difference is.
