Grammar/Punctuation P1 vowels, sentences, capital letters and full stops P2 vowels, consonants, dictionaries, alphabetical order

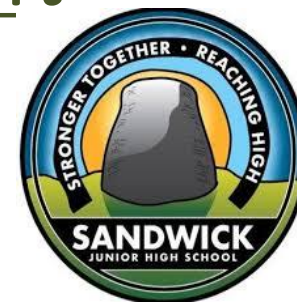
