See what makes the biggest footprint.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Bare Feet or Wellies</li><li>• Jumping or standing</li><li>• One foot vs two feet</li><li>• Tiptoes or flat feet</li></ul> <p>Stay warm and cosy and enjoy playing in the snow.</p>
