## Literacy

**Reading:** Reading groups heard through the week. ERIC time everyday after lunch. Choice reading books on Fridays.

**Writing:** We are continuing with our writing programme. We have moved onto our third focus which is vocabulary (wow-words). Once this is complete, we will move onto our next focus which is spelling.

**Spelling/Phonics:** Wraparound spelling through the week, using the sounds from Jolly Grammar.

**Handwriting:** Letter formation, fine motor skills.

**Grammar/Punctuation:** Focus on nouns/proper nouns, moving onto verbs and conjunctions. Constant focus on punctuating sentences through the writing project.

**Library** - Weekly library slot to read for pleasure and choose a book for home.

## Health & Wellbeing
